History & General Information

Marine Corps History - JULY

Marine Corps Establishment Becomes Law 11 July 1798 / President John Adams approves "An Act for Establishing and Organizing a Marine Corps". The following day William Ward Burrows was appointed Commandant and in August Major Burrows opened his headquarters in Philadelphia, which was still the capital at that time.

[The Continental Navy and Marines established in 1775 were disbanded at the end of the Revolutionary War and the Marine Corps was re-established in 1798. The Marine Corps celebrates its Original Birthday, 10 November 1775.]

28 July 1918 / Brigadier General John A. Lejeune assumed command of the 2nd Division, U.S. Army in France. He was the first Marine officer to hold an Army divisional command.

26 July 1947 / National Security Act of 1947 reaffirmed the status of the Marine Corps as a separate military service within the Department of the Navy. The Act provided for Fleet Marine Forces and confirmed the Marine Corps mission of seizing and defending advanced bases and of land operations incident to naval campaigns.

One item of interest is that Florida drivers licenses will now spell out the word Veteran on the license instead of just having the letter V. These licenses must be requested and a DD-214 is required.

MCL National Information

JULY

The national website (www.mcleague.org) is down permanently and the new website is up, but under construction (www.mclnational.org).

National Convention will be held on 9-15 August 2015 in Scottsdale Plaza Resort, Scottsdale AZ.

This space is under development and will have additional information in the future.

One item of interest is the national Veterans ID Card which is intended to replace / supplement the DD-214. All veterans will be eligible to have the Veterans ID Card. This has passed both houses of Congress and is headed for President Obama's signature (and he is expected to sign it). It is intended to be a more convenient form of proof of service than having to carry around the DD-214. It would be issued by the VA and "veterans who opted for the ID card would have a small fee" to pay. The MCL will need to determine if the new ID Card will be an acceptable alternative to the DD-214 for membership. Our Gator Detachment Officers have decided to continue requiring the DD-214.
