History & General Information

Marine Corps History - AUGUST



24 August 1814 Marine detachment from the Marine Barracks, Washington DC fought in the battle of Bladensburg for the defense of the national capital. They held off three charges before being encircled and forced to retire to avoid capture. Marines had 8 killed and 14 wounded.

7 August 1942 Guadalcanal campaign began. It lasted until February 1943 and was the beginning of a long island hopping fight to reach Japan. The Marines had nearly 3,000 wounded and over 1,100 dead during the battle.

21 August 1968 PFC James Anderson, Jr. was posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor for heroism in Vietnam while serving as a rifleman in February 1967. This was the first Medal of Honor presented to an African American Marine.

23 August 1984 Last Marines to serve peace keeping duty in Lebanon arrived home. The 24th Marine Amphibious Unit left Beirut on 31 July. This marked the last presence of U.S. combat troops in Beirut since Marines entered two years earlier.

7 August 1990 U.S. military troops were ordered to Saudi Arabia as part of a multinational force to defend that nation against possible Iraqi invasion. One week later the Marine Corps announced a commitment of 45,000 Marines to the Persian Gulf as part of Operation Desert Shield

The INJURED WARRIORS FUND OF FLORIDA has now disbursed over **\$65,000** to needy combat injured warriors.

The SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM this year has now awarded **\$450** each to over 40 recipients.

The LEADERSHIP PROGRAM at the 2015 Fall Conference had nearly **40** participants.

The BOY SCOUTS (EAGLE) PROGRAM will award **156** Good Citizenship Awards.

Department of Florida membership stands at over **3,700** with an additional 630 delinquent members. A major effort will be made this year to reduce this number. **Our Gator Detachment has already made significant progress - we now have no delinquent members.** Also, the Department of Florida was awarded the **Tom Perrone Award** for having the most new members.

Discounts are now available to veterans on Florida public park entrance fees. Also, publicly operated airports are now prohibited from charging parking fees to vehicles with disabled veteran license plates.

The ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION took place at Tulsa OK on 7-12 August 2016. See the national website for information on this Convention.

VA Airborne Hazards and Open Burn Pit Registry is now open to veterans who served after August 1990 in Operation Desert Shield, Operation Desert Storm, Operation Enduring Freedom, Operation Iraqi Freedom, Operation New Dawn, Djibouti, or Africa. (For respiratory and related health conditions.)

MCL has instituted a new **Honorary Active Duty membership category**. Active Duty Marines, FMF Corpsman, and FMF Chaplains can now become Honorary Active Duty members (free) of the MCL for the duration of their enlistment. They will have all rights and privileges of a regular member, except for voting or holding elective office.
